

# Manual for Protective Box Alu - Goodnature A24

Instructions for mounting and maintenance of the protective box

# 1. Mounting

# **Directions for Mounting**

Use gloves when mounting the protective box and the trap. The only tool required is a hex key and potentially a screw driver for mounting the box on a surface.


# Follow these steps:

- Remove the locking pin to open the box (according picture 1) and slide the lid/front/cover upwards.
- Mount the trap on the entrance plate (according picture 2). Only use screws that are included which fit the hinging:
  - A. The long screw from above closest to the box entrance.
  - B. The short screw from below at the back of the plate.
- 3. Mount the trap according to the trap manual.
- 4. Place the trap mounted on the entrance plate in the box (picture 2).
  - C. Place the rails in the corresponding holes in the floor of the box.
  - D. Secure one corner with wire or cable tie to the wall of the box (this secures that the trap will stay in place when operating).
- 5. Slide the lid/front/cover in position from above and make sure the protruding rails sink in to the holes in the bottom of the box.
- 6. Mount the box against a wall or on the ground (Note: Screws not included).
- 7. Put the locking pin in position and if desired use a padlock to lock the box (picture 1).

Note: If you want to remove the traps' orange mounting pad it first needs to be removed from the entrance plate mounting.

# 2. Maintenance

### **General Maintenance**

Use gloves when mounting the protective box and the trap. This to avoid scent traces which otherwise may affect trap effectiveness.

Do not place the box so that it is fully or partially submerged in water at any point in time. Both the box and the trap are weather resilient but can be damaged from standing in water.

# **Regular Controls**

Make sure to check the box and the trap on a regular basis. To see that the items have not been exposed to any external force which may impact functions. For example fallen branches, leafs or animals stuck in the box entrance or vandalism.

Immediately remedy any damages or take the box and trap out of operations for the time being (pending repairs). Safety cannot be guaranteed when box or trap are damaged which may cause injuries to people or animals.

# **Regular Maintenance**

The box requires no regular maintenance aside from general cleaning when needed.

For the Goodnature A24 trap consult the trap manual for regular maintenance and replacement of consumables.
